Histoplasma galactomannan is frequently detected in urine from patients with disseminated histoplasmosis. However, a negative result does not exclude a diagnosis of histoplasmosis. Many patients with acute pulmonary disease or chronic cavitory disease do not exhibit antigenuria. Specimens from patients with other endemic fungal infections, such as blastomycosis, paracoccidioidomycosis, or candidiasis, may also be positive in this assay.

This test should be used in conjunction with other diagnostics tests, including culture, molecular assays, and histology in making a final diagnosis.
