| Specimen Required | Swab specimens (endocervix, endourethral, conjuctiva, rectal, peritoneal) in viral transport medium. Send refrigerated. Specimen source is required. | | |
| Rejection Criteria | Urine specimens are not acceptable for culture (See chlamydia by TMA). Rectal swabs or stool preserved in formalin, SAF, or PVA. Specimens in Amplicore, EIA, Gen-Probe, or Probetec Transport media. Specimens in bacterial transport media, Stewart medium (Culturette). Specimens in bacteriological blood culture media. Dry swabs, wooden swabs, calcium alginate swabs, and swabs in gel transports. Specimens received in nonsterile or leaking containers, Respiratory specimens including nasopharyngeal, throat, BAL, Bronchial washes. | | |

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
