Anaplasma phagocytophilum is the tick-borne agent causing Human Granulocytic Ehrlichiosis (HGE). HGE is distinct and separate from Human Monocytic Ehrlichiosis (HME), caused by Ehrlichia chaffeensis. Serologic cross-reactivity between A. phagocytophilum and E. Chaffeensis is minimal (5-15%).

This test was developed and its analytical performance characteristics have been determined by Quest Diagnostics. It has not been cleared or approved by FDA. This assay has been validated pursuant to the CLIA regulations and is used for clinical purposes.
