This procedure cannot distinguish Chlamydia trachomatis from other Chlamydia species but Chlamydia psittaci and Chlamydia pneumoniae are rarely isolated from the genital tract. Vaginal cultures are not recommended due to low sensitivity. Chlamydia culture is appropriate for cervical, urethral, rectal, and/or eye swabs; nasopharyngeal swabs, aspirates or washes; and cul-de-sac fluids. Testing of other specimens has not been validated.

A negative result does not preclude infection. Chlamydia viability can be degraded if specimens are improperly collected or stored. False negative results can also occur when the number of viable organisms is below the detection threshold and when specimen collection occurs 1-5 days after starting treatment.
