An index value of <1.30 indicates IgG antibodies to West Nile virus were not detected. The absence of IgG antibodies is presumptive evidence that the patient was not infected with West Nile virus or another flavivirus. However, the sample may have been drawn before antibodies were detectable, or the patient may be immunosuppressed. If infection is suspected, another sample should be drawn 7 - 14 days later and tested. Refer to the CDC guidelines for diagnosis of West Nile encephalitis.

An index value of <0.90 indicates IgM antibodies to West Nile virus were not detected. The absence of IgM antibodies is presumptive evidence that the patient was not recently infected with West Nile virus or another flavivirus. However, the sample may have been drawn before antibodies were detectable, or the patient may be immunosuppressed. If infection is suspected, then another sample should be drawn 7 to 14 days later and tested. Refer to CDC guidelines for diagnosis of West Nile encephalitis.
