



## **99<sup>th</sup> Percentile Values for Antiphospholipid Antibodies**

It is occasionally of clinical use to compare a patient's antiphospholipid antibody concentration to 99<sup>th</sup> percentile values for the particular assay and patient population. Below we have provided the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile cutoffs for Warde's antiphospholipid antibody assays (data from 2024).

Anti-Cardiolipin IgG: 42 GPL

Anti-Cardiolipin IgA: 26 APL

Anti-Cardiolipin IgM: 89 MPL

Anti-Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgG: 81 U/mL

Anti-Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgA: 40 U/mL

Anti-Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgM: 76 U/mL

These results are in close agreement with 2023 values as well (same assay has been in use). This page will be updated periodically with current measurements.
