

99th Percentile Values for Antiphospholipid Antibodies

It is occasionally of clinical use to compare a patient's antiphospholipid antibody concentration to 99th percentile values for the particular assay and patient population. Below we have provided the 99th percentile cutoffs for Warde's antiphospholipid antibody assays (data from 2024).

Anti-Cardiolipin IgG: 42 GPL Anti-Cardiolipin IgA: 26 APL Anti-Cardiolipin IgM: 89 MPL Anti-Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgG: 81 U/mL Anti-Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgA: 40 U/mL Anti-Beta-2 Glycoprotein IgM: 76 U/mL

These results are in close agreement with 2023 values as well (same assay has been in use). This page will be updated periodically with current measurements.
