This Thyroglobulin test was performed by tandem mass spectrometry (LC/MS/MS) and does provide quantitative measurements of thyroglobulin in the presence of anti-Tg antibodies. Values obtained from different assay methods cannot be used interchangeably. Thyroglobulin levels, regardless of value, should not be interpreted as absolute evidence of the presence or absence of disease.
